Lots of the food that we eat comes from plants, like fruit, vegetables and grains.



Materials

- 1. cardboard stock/ construction paper

 2. muffin wrappers

 3. sccds

 4. pipe cleaners (green and brown)
- 5. clear tape

 6. scissors

 7. green felt

 8. felt tip pens



Activities to do at home: Make each part of the plant.

 Tape construction paper to the bottom third of the cardboard stock.



Tape a green pipe cleaner just above the construction paper.



Tape a muffin wrapper above the green pipe cleaner.



 Tape brown pipe cleaners to the brown construction paper to look like roots.



Tape seeds to the centre of muffin wrapper.



6. Cut leaf shapes from felt.




Tape leaves to the green pipe cleaner.
