



Nursery Curriculum Overview



Summer Term One

Below is an overview of the things your child will be learning in Nursery this half term so that you can continue to support your child's development at home. In addition to this overview your child will also be focusing on the topic 'Garden' where they will be learning about mini-beasts living in the garden, how seeds grow and how to look after plants.

As a part of the children's topic work, the children will be asked to attend Nursery dressed as a bug on Monday 26th April, in order to attend the Ugly Bug Ball. On this day, the children will take part in various fun activities and enjoy attending the ball itself.

Show and tell will take place each Friday. This term we will continue to adhere to the health and safety guidelines surrounding the current pandemic, and therefore staff in Nursery will provide objects for the children to talk about during these sessions. Please do not allow your child to bring anything from home during this time. Thank you.

PE will take place on a Monday with Mrs Harper. Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school and that jewellery is not worn.
