## Maths

In Year 4 we will be continuing to focus upon number bonds and times tables. They will continue to take part in weekly times table tests to develop their knowledge. We will continue to learn new methods linked to addition, multiplication, subtraction and division, applying them to problem solving.

## English

This term's English will focus on Persuasive Writing, Narratives and a range of other text types.

The children will be encouraged to use a variety of vocabulary, conjunctions, openers and punctuation (VCOP) to enable them to make their writing exciting, ensuring it engages the reader. We will continue to work on spelling, grammar and punctuation skills (SPAG) throughout the year during our daily OMS.

## Science

In Science the children will be learning living things and their habitats. They will be exploring different kingdoms, where they will learn about the classifying animals and investigating their habitats. The children will be carrying out investigations to explore this subject.

## MFL

In Year 4 the children will continue to learn French. We will be looking at family members, animals and hobbies. The children will have the chance to role play different French experiences.

## Religious Education

The children will be learning about Sikhism; growing up in a Sikh family as well as Sikhism in our neighbourhood. They will compare places of worship and their significance in the community.

## Art

In Art the children will be learning about Comic Strips by researching popular artists. Then we will look at 'Natural Forms'. We will be using our environment to aid our learning. Our focuses will be texture, line drawings, repeat patterns and colour.

## Geography

Our topic for Geography will continue to be Asia. We will look at the human geography of Asia, including the distribution of resources and housing.

## P.E

This term the children will have a variety of PE taught by Soccer 2000 and Mrs Jones (dance).

## History

Our topic for History will be comparing 'Anglo Saxons' to the 'Vikings'. Throughout the term, we will be creating a factfile about the Anglo Saxons and Vikings and their impact on our lives today.

## Music

In Music we will be exploring technical vocabulary as well as creating music using a rhythm and pulse.

## Computing

The children will be developing their skills on a range of programmes. This half term we will be focusing on researching and presenting information using PowerPoint and Word.
