



Year 4 Summer Term



Welcome back, we hope you had an exciting and enjoyable Easter Break! The first half term we will focus on history and Geography and in the second half term we get to create some exciting music and art projects.

Maths

In Year 4 this term, we will be developing our understanding of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will learn how to apply our skills to tricky word and reasoning problems. . There will continue be a strong focus on times tables, rapidly recalling them in preparation for the 'in house' Multiplication Test, which will be coming up soon! We will also be moving to looking at 2D shapes and their properties, symmetry and angles.

English

This term English will focus on story spinners looking at stories with dilemmas which will lead into Newspaper reports.

The children will be encouraged to use a variety of vocabulary, conjunctions, openers and punctuation (VCOP) to enable them to make their writing exciting, ensuring it engages the reader.

We will continue to work on spelling, grammar and punctuation skills (SPAG) throughout the term during our

The children will be learning about different places of worship, their place in the community and their significance to each religion.

Art/ DT

As part of our Ancient Greece topic, the children will be beginning to learn about weaving and how Ancient Greeks made clothes. As part of our Hey Mr DJ topic, in the second half term, the children will design and make a stage with lights appropriate for a music video. In Art, children will use sculpting techniques to create movable models for animation.

Geography

Our topic for Geography will continue to be 'Greece' looking at how it is a part of Europe.

P.E

This term the children will have a variety of PE. They will have a lesson of games twice a week which will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

History

Music

In music we will be learning about different genres and begin to make our own music applying the knowledge we learn about rhythm, beats and instrumentals.

Computing

Children will use their computing skills to produce a piece of music by layering sounds. They will also use iPads to create a stop-motion animation music video to accompany their track. We will continue to deepen their understanding of E-safety and the importance of staying safe online.

Science

In Science the children will be learning about living things and their habitats. They will be exploring different kingdoms, where they will learn about the classifying animals and investigating their habitats. The children will be carrying out investigations to explore this subject.
