



Year 5 Summer Term

Maths

In Mathematics, we will begin with looking at long division with two digit numbers. We will also be looking at time and times tables in real life context.

In the final half term, we will be spending more learning time on geometry focusing on angles and 2D/3D shapes. We will be recapping on perimeter and area of shapes before moving on to finding volume. Again, children will be given opportunities to apply their knowledge of the four rules of number through a range of rich problem solving activities.

Alongside maths lessons, children will also be taking part in arithmetic lessons where they will concentrate on their mental and written skills in weekly practice assessments.

English

In English we will start summer 1 with a unit based on short stories. Children will also continue to improve their grammatical knowledge and receive weekly spellings, so that they are well prepared for Year 6. Children will be studying a range of fiction and non-fiction texts covering different genres. We will also be doing weekly comprehensions.

Science

This term, we shall continue to develop our science skills and knowledge with a focus of Earth and Space- Out of this world! In the second half of the term, we will be looking at humans from birth to adult.

Religious Education

In RE, we will be looking at 'Keeping the five pillars of Islam.'

Art

As artists, the children will be continuing their work on Ruth Daniels with last term being so short.

Design and Technology

The children will be designing and making their own South American meal. We will be tasting and creating an authentic three course meal.

P.E

Soccer 2000 will continue to teach PE in Year 5, they will be focusing on athletics. Children will be taught gymnastics weekly. PE lessons are still on Tuesdays and Fridays.

History

Our historical learning is geared around the Battle of Britain. We will be studying the key events and people of The Battle of Britain and how it changed the course of WW2.

Geography

As geographers the children will be learning about the human impact of South America. We will be focusing on deforestation and its positive and negative effects.

Music

As musicians the children will be learning to sing songs and finding out how to accompany their songs with simple percussion instruments. They will also be learning how to create rounds using a range of percussion.

Computing

In computing we will continue to learn about e-safety. We are also investigating different coding software and experimenting with programming using a range of software and hardware.

Homework

As well as completing their reading journals and spellings, the children will have the opportunity to complete homework tasks. These will be given out on a weekly basis.
