Maths

As mathematicians in Year 6 the children will be concentrating on all four operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and applying these taught skills in a range of different ways. As you are aware Year 6 SATs will take place in May, therefore the children will be exposed to various arithmetic and reasoning style questions, in preparation for this.

English

In English children will continue to explore a range of genres including formal and persuasive writing. We will be developing key reading skills in our guided reading and our whole class reading sessions. Children will be developing a range of key writing skills, which will include using a range of word choices, sentence variations and higher level of punctuation.

Science

As scientists the children will find out about Evolution and Inheritance through research and investigation. There will be a big focus on working scientifically and allowing the children to explore through Science and learn to make predictions, question their findings and report back.

Religious Education

The children will be learning about what makes a place respectful and how we as humans can help to make an area more respectful.

Art

As artists the children will be creating visionary pieces of artwork based around our History topic – The Aztecs.

Design and Technology

In DT, children will be planning and creating their own Aztec pot using clay.

P.E

This term there will be a focus on multi sports in games lessons. Children will be learning how to throw and catch using different apparatus. The children will also have a weekly dance lesson for the first term then move onto gymnastics after half term.

History

History is taught chronologically, so Y6 children will be learning about The Aztecs.

Geography

In Geography the children will be using their mapping skills to identify local, National and European countries and cities.

Music

As musicians children are taught musical terms such as tempo, pulse and beat.

Computing

In Computing, children will be learning coding and programming. There will be an emphasis on E safety.
