This first half term we will focus on History and Design Technology, followed by Geography and Art during the second half of the Autumn term.</p>	<p>Religious Education</p> <p>The children will be looking at why God is important to Jewish people and then move onto learning about key leaders in the Hinduism and Sikhism faiths.</p>
<p>Maths</p> <p>In year 4 we will be continuing to focus upon number bonds and times tables. They will practice number bonds to 10, 100 and 1000 as well as continuing with the development of their times tables knowledge. We will continue to learn new methods linked to the four rules and then apply them to problem solving.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>Art this term will be closely linked to our History and Geography topics. Starting with Anglo Saxon Jewellery and artefacts.</p> <p>Geography</p> <p>As Geographers, children will focus on the physical and human features of the Asian continent.</p> <p>Design and Technology</p>
<p>English</p> <p>This term English will focus on a poetry unit, followed by persuasive writing linked to our History topic of 'Anglo Saxons'.</p> <p>The children will be encouraged to use a variety of vocabulary, conjunctions, openers and punctuation (VCOP) to enable them to make their writing exciting, ensuring it engages the reader.</p> <p>We will continue to work on spelling, grammar and punctuation skills (SPAG) throughout the year during our daily OMS.</p>	<p>In D&T the children will be investigating, designing and making a range of healthy dishes.</p> <p>P.E</p> <p>This term there will be a focus on invasion games, learning about a range of ball skills and team sports, as well as dance.</p> <p>History</p> <p>Our topic for History will be 'Anglo Saxons'. We will look at how and why they invaded and their impact on Britain.</p>
<p>Science</p> <p>In Science the children will further their understanding of sound during the first half term. They will continue to develop their investigative skills while using their scientific vocabulary. Lots of exciting and noisy experiments to be planned and undertaken during this topic!</p> <p>Electricity will be our science topic in the second part of the Autumn term.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>In Music children will explore 'rhythmic patterns' and learn how to create arrangements using a variety of instruments.</p> <p>Computing</p> <p>The children will be developing their skills on a range of programmes. This half term we will be focusing on coding with ongoing learning surrounding internet safety.</p> <p>MFL</p> <p>In Year 4 the children will continue to learn French. We will focus on recapping their learning from year 3 and then developing this further. We will be learning all about numbers, colours and different animals.</p>
